

**CITY OF LYNDON
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, AUGUST 25, 2014**

The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Barto at 6:00p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present: Jim Baker, Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Becky Ricketts, Cathy Robertson, Mary Watson and City Attorney John Singler. Mardy Sidebottom was absent.
