

**CITY OF LYNDON
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, MARCH 25, 2013**

The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Barto at 6:00p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present: Jim Baker, Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Becky Ricketts, Cathy Robertson, Mary Watson and City Attorney John Singler. Mardy Sidebottom was absent.

A motion and a second were made to approve the minutes of the February 25, 2013 Council Meeting. Motion carried unanimously. A motion and a second were made to approve the minutes of the March 18, 2013 Caucus Meeting. Becky Ricketts made one correction. Those who made the motion and seconded, agreed to amend the minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

ORDINANCE #2-25-13 – 2nd Reading – Amending Codified Ordinance Section 111.04 (A) pertaining to Peddlers, Itinerant Merchants and Solicitors A motion and a second were made to give the second reading by summary of Ordinance #2-25-13. Motion carried unanimously. Mr. Singler, attorney, gave the second reading. A motion and a second were made to approve Ordinance #2-25-13. Upon roll call vote the following voted "aye": Jim Baker, Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Becky Ricketts, Cathy Robertson, Mary Watson. No one voted "nay". Motion carried unanimously.

ORDINANCE #3-25-13, Series 2013- 1st Reading – Repealing and Replacing Ord. 9-26-11A, Series 2011 of Fire Code – A motion and a second were made to have Attorney, John Singler give a 1st reading by summary of Ordinance #3-25-13. Mr. Singler gave the first reading. The second reading and action of Ordinance #3-25-13 will be placed on the April Council Meeting agenda.

AWARDING GROUNDS MAINTENANCE BIDS - A motion and a second were made to accept S.A.M's bid of \$32,240 for mowing. Motion carried unanimously. A motion and a second were made to accept Lawnco, Inc.'s bid of \$54,405 for general maintenance of city grounds. Motion carried unanimously.

OTHER BUSINESS:

The Mayor thanked the volunteers who helped at the Easter Egg Hunt last Saturday at Romara. She mentioned there was a good turnout. Despite a few minor things that may need to be changed, she believed it was a success.
