

**CITY OF LYNDON
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, DECEMBER 21, 2015**

The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Barto at 6:00p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present: Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Nicole Nash, Becky Ricketts, Cathy Robertson, Mardy Sidebottom, Mary Watson and City Attorney John Singler.

A motion was made by Mary Watson, seconded by Nicole Nash to approve the minutes of the November 23, 2015 Council Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was given and will be filed for audit. Balance for December 1, 2015 was \$5,007,619.29

The Mayor brought up the KLC partnership with Compliance Connections website that will help the city find responsible parties on foreclosed properties. The City Treasurer and City Clerk have both registered.

The Mayor also mentioned a few other items. The Westport Middle School Orchestra had a great concert and they were very appreciative of the grant. Nicole Nash said she could see the benefit. The Mayor also informed the council the salt storage building is under way and will be ready in 2 weeks. There was also a discussion about the City taking back the Lyndon fair. An interest to hire a company to coordinate it and dates were discussed.

Betsy Kramer asked Chief, Grady Throneberry if he has an update on the vandalism on Wood Rd. He said the vandals hit Graymoor-Devondale before Lyndon but no recent news to report.

Becky Ricketts made sure the Lyndon fair wouldn't affect the Lyndon Summer Concert dates set. The Mayor reminded her the concerts are in July, August and September.
