

**CITY OF LYNDON  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, JULY 27, 2015**

The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Barto at 6:00p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present: Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Nicole Nash, Becky Ricketts, Cathy Robertson, Mardy Sidebottom, Mary Watson and City Attorney John Singler.

A motion was made by Mary Watson, seconded by Betsy Kramer to approve the minutes of the June 22, 2015 Council Meeting. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Mary Watson, seconded by Nicole Nash to approve the minutes of the July 20, 2015 Caucus Meeting. Nicole Nash pointed out one error to correct. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was given and will be filed for audit. Balance for July 1, 2015 was \$4,151,479.47.

Erin White, candidate for Jefferson District Judge attended the meeting and introduced herself.

**ORDINANCE #7-27-15- 1<sup>st</sup> Reading- Amending Codified Ordinance Chapter 32, Section 21 Relating to City Council Meetings-** A motion was made by Becky Ricketts, seconded by Betsy Kramer to have Attorney, John Singler give a 1<sup>st</sup> reading by summary of Ordinance #7-27-15. Mr. Singler gave the first reading and it will be placed on the August Council agenda for action.

**MUNICIPAL ORDER #7-27-15A- LOU-E Grant** – A motion was made by Cathy Robertson, seconded by Carla Nalley to approve Municipal Order #7-27-15A. Cathy Robertson and Becky Ricketts both expressed their disappointment with the organization. Motion carried unanimously.

The Mayor asked the council to consider approving a concept to take over Forest Village roads before they hire an engineer to do a study. Discussion was held. A motion was made by Cathy Robertson, seconded by Betsy Kramer to approve the concept. Motion carried unanimously.

The Mayor also brought up the Birk Lane petition. Property owners from Birk Lane were expected to come to meeting but no one attended. The City will inform them they have not yet met requirements to be considered for approval.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

Mrs. Robertson asked if the City has asked Allegra about a newsletter template. The Mayor said Gary Owen has contacted the City but a template is yet to be chosen.

The Mayor mentioned the ad for the gazebo at Romara was sent to paper to be published this week. Bids are due before next Caucus and will be opened that evening.

Becky Ricketts asked about better ways to advertise for city's upcoming concerts. She was informed of the list of advertising mediums the city has contacted and she was urged to share the information if she had further ideas.

Mayor Barto announced the next Caucus Meeting on August 17, 2015 and Council Meeting is August 24, 2015, both at 6:00pm.

Ric Gilliespie, resident of Holly Springs, asked if he could have a copy of the municipal order we passed this evening. The Mayor instructed him to fill out an open records request and a copy will be made for him.
