MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2016**

ANNOUNCEMENTS:


The Mayor announced the next Caucus Meeting will be October 17, 2016 and the Council Meeting will be October 24, 2016, both at 6:00 pm.

A few of the boy scouts spoke up and shared what they were learning and one thanked the Council for the money to fund the fitness trail at Bowen.


ADJOURNMENT:
