

**CITY OF LYNDON
CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2020**

The Caucus Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brent Hagan at 6:00 p.m. Those present: Susan Barto, Betsy Kramer, Kelly Kramer, Carla Nalley, Becky Ricketts, Mardy Sidebottom, Amy Stuber and City Attorney John Singler. One guest was present.

Mayor Hagan allowed the guest, Eric Panknin, owner of Louisville Pawn, LLC, to speak first at meeting. The small business owner applied for the CARES Grant but was denied since he had received federal funds previously. He asked the city to consider allowing grants that other federal programs have not covered. Long discussion was held. City Attorney, John Singler, will draft an amendment to our municipal order regarding the policy and application process if City Council chooses to approve additional funding.

Council brought up about a few topics (voting, Halloween) that did not require City solutions. Betsy Kramer asked about citation process and the neighborhood meeting notice Becky Ricketts received for the proposal at the end of Washington Blvd was discussed. Kelly Kramer asked again about the wrong-way driving on ramp at Hurstbourne Estates at Morat and Hurstbourne Pkwy. The Mayor stated the City could put a "Do No Enter" if there is city right-of-way available.

Several other discussions were held. Susan Barto brought up someone stealing out of open cars in neighborhood. Carla Nalley inquired about responsibility of Lake Ave for purposes of speed humps. Ms. Ricketts asked about recently staked Ormsby Lane properties that border the city-owned properties. The Mayor explained they had submitted three building applications although they were denied because the driveways came off of Ormsby Lane.


