ORDINANCE 10-28-19, SERIES 2019
CASE NO. 19-STRCLOSURE-0006

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE STREET CLOSURE
OF JEFFERSON TERRACE

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndon has the authority pursuant to the Development Code and KRS 82.405 to close, in whole, or in part, a city street, such as Jefferson Terrace; and

WHEREAS, the Louisville Metro Planning Commission has recommended in favor of said closure of Jefferson Terrace in Case Number 19-STRCLOSURE-0006;

WHEREAS, all property owners in or abutting the public way or portion thereof being closed in Case Number 19-STRCLOSURE-0006, have given their written notarized consent to the closing and copies of the consent are in the Planning Commission record in the above cited case,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LYNDON:

1. The City of Lyndon does hereby elect to close the street of Jefferson Terrace as recommended by the Louisville Metro Planning Commission, Case No. 19-STRCLOSURE-0006. This decision to close said street has been made after the Lyndon Council made the following findings of fact:
 - (a) The City has identified all property owners in or abutting the public way or portion thereof to be closed; and
 - (b) Notice of the proposed closing was given to all property owners in or abutting the public way or portion thereof being closed, and
 - (c) All property owners in or abutting the public way or a portion thereof being closed has given their written notarized consent to the closing. Copies of the consent are in the Planning Council record.
2. The decision to close the above described roadway has been made by the City of Lyndon pursuant to the statutory authority of KRS 82.405.
3. The City of Lyndon has provided procedural and substantive due process in completing the procedure permitted under KRS 82.405
4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its reading, passage and publication, in accordance with law.
